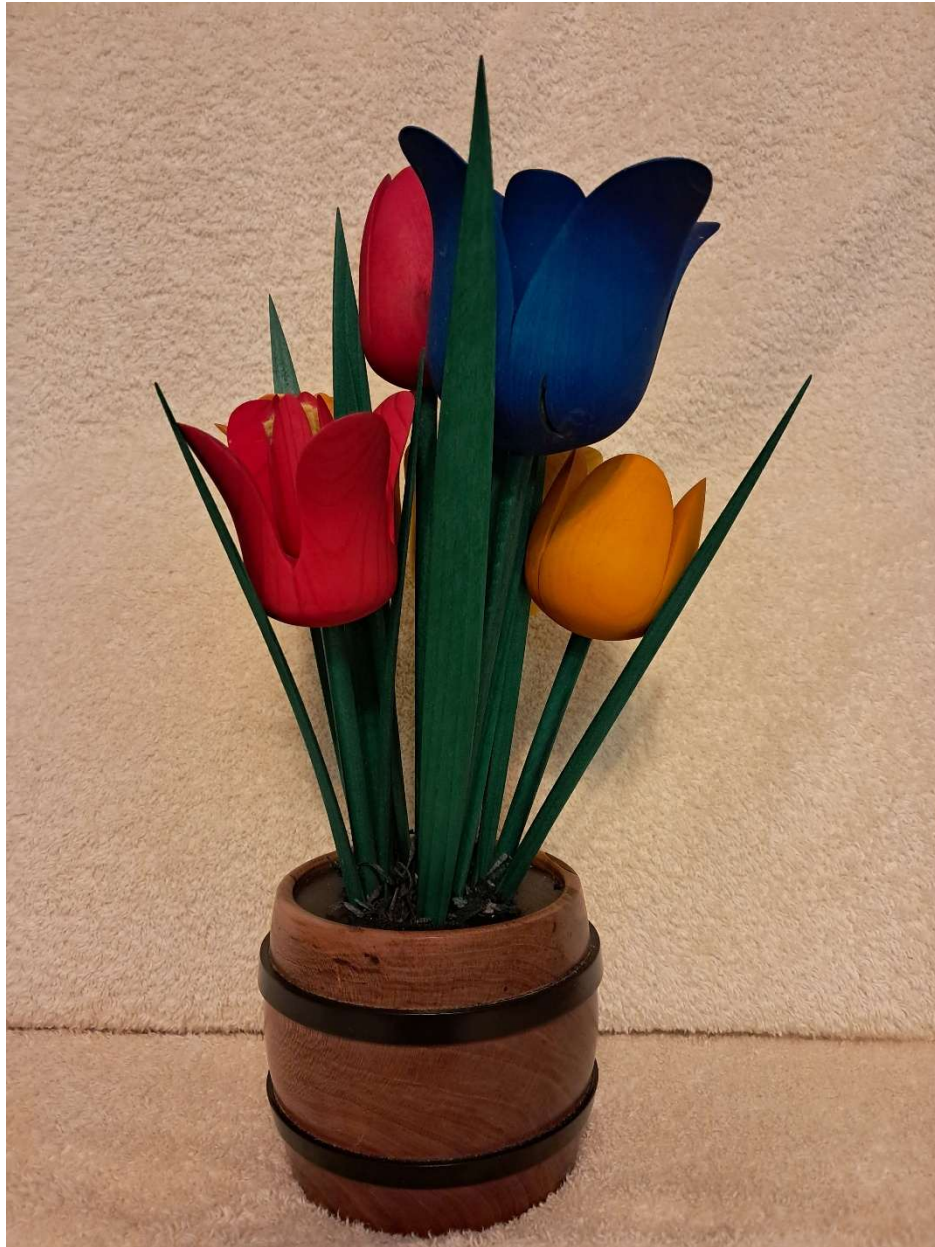


Helpful guide on turning Tulips



I use Poplar square stock sizes from $\frac{1}{2}$ " through $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 36" depending on the size of tulip I want.

It requires four pieces 3" long to make a single tulip.

The 1" and smaller works best for the closed and partially open.

The $1\frac{1}{4}$ " and larger better for the fully opened.

The closed, partially opened, & fully opened starts out the same way.
